
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### How do we build the budget?



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#### **Statutory Requirements**

- NC Chapter 159 establishes the budget process
- A budget is defined as a proposed plan for raising and spending money for specified programs, functions, activities or objectives during a fiscal year.
- County Manager must present a budget by June 1
- County must hold a public hearing on the budget.
- Board of Commissioners must adopt a balanced budget (revenues = expenses)
- Budget must be adopted by June 30
- Budget runs from July 1 June 30

#### Where does the money go?

The County spends the most on Education (public schools and community college), followed by Successful People (Public Health, Social Services, Child Support); Strong Community (Law Enforcement, Emergency Services, Parks); then General Government (Board of Commissioners, Administration, Finance, Facilities, Information Technology).

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






### Funding for School Bonds






#### Annual Debt Repayment for Guilford County Schools
