



TERMINATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY GUILFORD COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of March, 2020 at 5:00pm, pursuant to Article 1a of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Article II of Chapter 7.5 of the Guilford County Code of Ordinances, a State of Emergency was declared within the jurisdiction of Guilford County due to the impacts of COVID-19, a respiratory disease caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus;

WHEREAS, said declaration of a State of Emergency applied to the entire jurisdiction of Guilford County; and

WHEREAS, conditions constituting a State of Emergency no longer exist in Guilford County.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Chairman of the Guilford County Board of Commissioners, it is hereby proclaimed that the State of Emergency declared on the 13th day of March, 2020, is terminated as of 5:00pm on the 15th day of August, 2022.
