

## Immunization/Health Screening Categories

### Category A

-All staff, students, and volunteers must have a screening for Tuberculosis (PPD) except for those in Animal Control. (Two-step testing will be provided to those employees whose job responsibilities put them at greater risk for TB exposure and will be TB tested on a routine basis.)

### Category B

All staff, students, and volunteers must show immunity to:

- Measles (Red)
- Mumps
- Rubella (German Measles)
- Varicella

### Category C

All staff, students, and volunteers in this category have the potential for exposure to blood/body fluids. They must be offered the Hepatitis B vaccine but may decline.

This category includes:

- Nurse specialist positions (RN and LPN)
- Nurse supervisor/consultant positions
- Physician/physician extender positions (nurse practitioner, physician assistant)
- Medical laboratory technologist/technician/manager/supervisor positions
- Public health/STD investigator/outreach positions
- Dental assistant/hygienist positions
- Dentists
- Nurse aide/assistant positions
- WIC nutritionist positions that require doing finger sticks (Devon Clinic and Head Start)
- Other identified positions which potentially include exposure to blood/body fluids

### Category D

Staff in Animal Control who work directly with animals, or who may potentially be asked to work directly with animals, should have the following:

- Rabies series immunization

The Health Department Human Resource Specialist will contact the Guilford County Occupational Health Provider when rabies vaccine will be needed for a new employee.
