WHAT

Starting July 1st, 2022 a new program will be available for Guilford County residents. The Beaver Assistance Management Program (BMAP) is a collaborative program designed to assist landowners with problems caused by beaver activity on private and public lands. Landholders will have access to assistance at a reduced cost-share rate.



Landholders can expect to pay the following cost-share fees for services:

- \$25 per site visit
- \$125 per dam removed

Initial damage assessments are provided at no charge. Beaver management specialists average 10 visits over a 30-day period to resolve the problem.

Landholders willing to conduct beaver management activities themselves are provided individual training at no cost.



WHO

Private and public landowners who reside in Guilford County will have access to this program. In addition the NC Department of Transportation also receives BMAP services.

Participants can expect to sign a cooperative service agreement (CSA) and a work initiation document giving written permission for services to be conducted on their lands.
