Rental Bike Program

Bikes are available for rental March through November. \$3 per hour with a 2-hour minimum

- 1. To rent a bike, an individual must provide personal identification and proof that they are at least 18 years of age. Acceptable identification includes: State of North Carolina issued ID card, driver's license or valid college ID. Persons 13 years of age and older may be allowed to use a Rental Bike if they are accompanied on the bike ride by a parent or legal guardian. Please note: The Rental Bicycles are adult sized bikes and to operate a bike the user must be at least 55 inches tall as recommended by the bicycle manufacturer's representative. *Persons younger than 13 years of age are prohibited from bike use.*
- 2. The rental bikes are available on days that the Wildlife Center is open. Bikes may be obtained starting at the posted facility opening time until two hours prior to the posted closing time for the facility. Bicycles must be returned to the facility no later than one half hour before the posted closing time. No lights are provided. Bikes may not be used during severe weather.
- 3. Any person obtaining a rental bike must leave a form of identification to be returned when the rental bike is brought back to the Wildlife Center. Acceptable identification includes: State of North Carolina issued ID card, driver's license or valid college ID.
- 4. Helmets are required for all users of the Rental Bikes and must be worn at all times the bike is in use. You may provide your own helmet or one can be obtained at the time of bike checkout.
- 5. To use a Rental Bike, you must sign a waiver of liability. Please be aware of your own personal skill level and do not attempt to ride a bike if you are not confident of your ability.
- 6. The bikes are single gear and reverse motion of the pedals are the only method to stop the bike. Rental Bikes are intended for use only on paved trails or park roads such as the Lake Brandt Greenway, Bicentennial Greenway, and Bur-Mil Park. Use of Rental Bikes on Highway 220/Battleground Avenue and any mountain bike trail is strictly prohibited (violators will lose their Rental Bike privileges).
- Always ride in a safe manner and be aware of other trail users and motor vehicles. Rental Bike
 program users must come to a full stop and look both ways prior to crossing any road or
 driveway.
- 8. Report any mechanical failures or damage to the Wildlife Center attendant. If the bike is not returned or damaged due to negligence and you will be charged a replacement cost or repair fee. Lost or stolen bikes will be reported to the Guilford County Sheriff's Department and restitution will be expected.
