

Medication Assistance Program

Do you need help purchasing your prescriptions? The Guilford County Department of Public Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP) may be able to help.

What is MAP?

MAP is the Medication Assistance Program. It is a completely grant-funded program, administered by the Guilford County Department of Public Health. It is a member of the Guilford Community Care Network (GCCN) and is funded by grants from the Cone Health Foundation, The North Carolina Health and Wellness Trust Fund Commission and The Blue Cross Blue Shield Foundation of North Carolina through the North Carolina Association of Free Clinics.

Who is eligible for MAP services?

- Adult Guilford County residents who have incomes at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Scale (\$21,660 if single, \$29,140 if married). These amounts may change yearly and depend on drug company program guidelines.
- Legal residents of Guilford County who have a doctor and take medicines for chronic conditions, but are not enrolled in any prescription drug coverage program.
- A person must meet both of the above criteria to be eligible.

Who is not eligible for MAP services?

- Residents who do not have a regular physician to provide their medical care.
- Residents who have Medicaid, Medicare Part D or private insurance coverage for prescription medicines.

What services does MAP offer?

Our pharmacist will meet with you:

- To review your medicines and your medical history.
- To provide information on how to use your drugs wisely.
- To help you lower your drug costs.

How much do MAP services cost?

All of the services provided at MAP are free of charge. MAP staff will also work with you to obtain medications at no cost. If this is not possible, you may be able to purchase them for a small fee.
