## Agenda

Harold Alexander moved to approve the agenda. Lewis Brandon seconded. The motion carried.

## Minutes

Lewis moved to approve the January 3rd, 2018 minutes. Harold seconded. The motion carried.

# Proposal to Host State Land Judging Contest November 9-10, 2018

- Jason Davis relayed details of holding the state land judging contest
  - We would need to pick a training and testing site (NC A&T farm was suggested)
  - Pick a menu for the lunch/banquet with a budget of \$1,500-2,000. Money would be reimbursed
  - Reach out to local schools with Ag/FFA programs to participate in the contest (Southern, Southeastern, and Eastern Guilford Middle/High Schools)
- Harold moved to approve hosting state land judging contest. Lewis seconded. The motion carried.

# **District Conservation Programs**

- Jamey Walker presented the Ag Cost Share Update
- 2 requests for payment were made:
  - Contract 41-2016-504, Dewey Hatcher for \$1,500; well closure (CCAP)
  - Contract 41-2017-006, Laura Honeycutt for \$3,128 cropland conversion (ACSP)
- Harold moved to approve payment requests for both contracts. Lewis seconded. The motion carried.
- VAD Report had no changes.

# Comment from County

 Leslie Bell updated the board about an event being held by Greensboro and Guilford County Watershed/Stormwater: Creek Week from March 17-24.

## Review of Draft 2018/19 Budget

- Leslie Bell reported the budget would be due March 2, 2018
- Leslie reviewed changes between this year's budget and that of the 2017/18 budget
  - There was a \$6,000 increase for the Operating Budget. Most budget expenses saw no significant value change, with the exception of significant increases in the budgets for professional services and other services and charges and significant decrease in small office furniture, fixtures, and equipment and supplies and materials.
  - There was a decrease projected in revenue for the Foundation Accounts Budget due to low sales in tree seedlings. The expenses for the Foundation Account Budget are predicted to stay relatively the same.
- Leslie requested that the board and Guilford SWCD decide if they want money dictated in the budget (prior to March 2) for:
  - o an equipment shed and proper permitting for building the shed
  - o education materials
  - o new no-till drill
  - funding for the state land judging contest

#### NRCS

- Brian Loadholt discussed the NRCS's progress in ranking EQIP applications and funding requests.
- Brian also mentions NRCS's movement to a new website (farmers.gov), which will have NRCS, FSA, and Risk Management all under one web address for customer service purposes.

## **District Operations**

- Millie presented the monthly expenditure report and the Foundation Report.
- The remaining supervisors signed their disclosure forms

- Millie reminded everyone of the date for the Tree Sale and requested that the board volunteer to set up Wednesday morning at 9AM.
- Millie confirmed the date of The Awards Banquet to be May 22<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 with booked catering.
- She also reminded supervisors of the upcoming Area 3 Envirothon and expressed the need for volunteers the date of the event (March 20).
- Pre-Registration forms and payment were collected by Kyleene for the Area 3 Spring Meeting being held March 1, 2018.
- The board filled out the NC Foundation for Soil & Water Conservation "Visioning" survey from last month's annual meeting.
