NOTE: **Minor** modification requests will be taken to the Technical Review Committee for recommendations prior to going to the Environmental Review Board for the final decision. The Environmental Review Board's decision can be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners.
Major modification requests follow the same review process as minor modification requests except that the Board of County Commissioners shall make a recommendation to the N.C. Environmental Management Commission who will make the final decision.
