### SCANNING PROJECT

- In March to July 2019, the Public Health Department entered into a project with a vendor to scan and index the approximate 70,000 hardcopy Well and Septic permit and support documents managed by the Water Quality group of the Environmental Health Division.
- The documents involved in this project were the working documents obtained from permits and inspections that occurred from 1980 until 2019.
- Permits and inspections older than 1980 will be scanned at a later date and are currently available for review in the Water Quality office.




#### IMAGE AVAILABILITY

The digital documents are associated with the individual parcel record as shown in the image to the right.

If a parcel record has a 'Water Quality' hyperlink, then it has documents available for viewing.

Clicking this link will provide access.

The individual parcel record can be accessed by using the **Search** or **Identify** tools in the application.

When the hyperlink is clicked, a PDF file will open in a new browser tab.

The first two (or more) pages will always be the 'Property Service Chart'. These pages act as an activity log to document past and future work performed on this parcel.

Other pages may include various permits, maps and other supporting documentation.
