BACK TO SCHOOL CHECK LIST FOR STUDENTS WITH HEALTH CONCERNS:

- ✓ Alert your child's school and school nurse regarding any medical conditions or issues pertaining to your child such as diabetes, asthma, allergies, migraines, seizures, etc. "Care plan" forms are available from the nurse to be completed by the parent to inform the school staff about the conditions and how your child should be taken care of in the event something happens during the school day.
- ✓ If medications are required to be taken during the school day, a "Medication Authorization" form must be completed for <u>ANY</u> medication given at school and must be completely filled out and signed by the doctor and parent before medications can be administered. These forms must be completed each school year. Pick up all medication by the last day of school to prevent them from being discarded during the summer.
- ✓ Assure that emergency contact information is current with the school.
- ✓ If your child requires a special diet, contact your school's cafeteria manager.
- ✓ You may choose to allow the school nurse to communicate directly with your doctor regarding your child's health conditions through completion of a "Two-way Consent" form.
- ✓ If your child sustains a concussion, you will need to have your doctor complete a "Return to Learn" form regarding restrictions in the classroom as well as a "Return to Play" form if they play sports.
