Jamey Walker updated the board on the May 2019 spotchecks. No contracts were out of compliance, but 4 needed maintenance. Letters will be sent to the land owners informing them that they must complete the maintenance to stay in compliance with their contracts.

Jamey Walker also updated the board that he obtained the site plan for the Carport Structure. He is just waiting for the permit application to be submitted and approved.

Comment from County

Leslie Bell introduced the board to the new Soil & Water Retention and Disposition Schedule for adoption. Leslie addressed that there were updates made to the Retention and Disposition Schedule at the state level in regards to long hard copies of public records and emails are kept, and that the Soil & Water Retention and Disposition Schedule reflected these state changes.

Harold Alexander moved to adopt the new Soil & Water Retention and Disposition Schedule. Josh Myers seconded. The motion carried.

Leslie also described the role Soil and Water Staff will play in the Stoney Creek Restoration Project. Guilford Soil and Water will apply for CCAP monies to help the restoration project as well as provide limited technical assistance throughout the project.

Josh Myers moved to endorse the Stoney Creek Restoration Project and will apply for CCAP funds as requested when the application period opens and affirmed that the Board has no known conflicts of interest in the project. Ray Briggs seconded. The motion carried.

NRCS

Harrison Wilkes announced NRCS had finished approving 33 EQUIP application over the 6 county area. There are 3 preapproved and one approved in Guilford County.

Brent Bogue introduced the new Acting Asst State Conservationist for Area 2, Jamie Keith. She informed the board that NRCS is now looking for someone to permanently fulfill that position as well as the supervisory conservationist position soon.

District Operations

- Millie reviewed the Monthly Expenditure Report. Money was spent to pay the caterer for the Awards
 Banquet and for the VISA Gift Cards awarded to the poster contest winners. The foundation account also
 received a \$500.00 donation from the Guilford Farm Credit Bureau and received money for rental equipment
 and bird houses.

- The board agreed that with a lack of business to discuss at the July board meeting that canceling it would be appropriate.
